Over 60's Lunch Club

Organised by LGVA and subsidised by the local council through Meals on Wheels, lunches were provided for a small cost in the hall for the over 60's once or twice a week until the mid 1990's when demand had dwindled.

Organised to help senior citizens visit friends and relations in hospital or at home, Transgreen met with limited response., and despite a good number of volunteer drivers, there was virtually no take-up of the scheme.

The Helping Hand Group was established in 1977 and ran for about 25 years. It eventually merged with the *TRANSGREEN* project established in 1974

The Group was made up of voluntary drivers who either regularly or occasionally undertook odd-jobs and provided much needed help to elderly or disabled residents by giving lifts to Dr's surgeries, hospitals etc. Members of the group displayed a green hand in their windows.

Youth Club

The Youth Club was organised on Friday Nights in the hall by local volunteers and continued intermittently (depending on demand and number of adult volunteers) through to the late 1980's.
